ORDINANCE NO. 2

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TRUCKS, TRACTORS, the USE OF ROADS, REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

SECTION A.

The Commissioners of the City of Glenview do ordain as follows:

(1) No vehicle shall be operated, propelled, or driven in a reckless manner and at any rate of speed in excess of 25 MPH, or in any manner as to endanger, or to be likely to endanger the life, limbs, or property or any person.

(2) Any person who drives a vehicle in such a manner as to indicate a willful or wanton disregard for the safety of other persons or property, shall be guilty of reckless driving.

(3) Any person who operates a vehicle in any manner as to disregard a stop sign or to disregard a direction of a police officer, shall be guilty of reckless and improper driving.

(4) The operation of any vehicle, except emergency vehicles at a speed of 25 MPH shall be prima facie evidence of reckless and improper driving.

SECTION B.

Trucks using any portion of any street or highway within the corporate limits of the City of Glenview may use said street or highway for local delivery purposes only. No truck shall be permitted to be operated on said street or highway with a gross maximum weight in excess of 18,000 lbs.

SECTION C.

No persons shall operate a motor propelled vehicle with lugs on wheels of such vehicles over the streets or highways within said corporate limits.

SECTION D.

This Ordinance shall not effect the street or highway within the incorporate boundaries of the City of Glenview known as River Road and Lime Kiln Lane, which street or highway shall be excluded from this ordinance. Traffic control on River Road and Lime Kiln Lane shall be controlled by the State of Kentucky and/or County of Jefferson.


PENALITIES

Any person who violates Section A, B, or C, of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00.

If any section, subsection, sentence or clause of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
