

CITY OF GLENVIEW
ORDINANCE 5A, SERIES 2002

An Ordinance regulating signs
in the City of Glenview

WHEREAS the City of Glenview is interested in preserving the natural beauty and attractiveness of the area within the City, and

WHEREAS it is deemed essential and prudent to limit and restrict the placement of signs within the City, and

WHEREAS this Ordinance amends, replaces and supersedes Ordinance 5, Series 2002 previously enacted by the Glenview City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the City of Glenview as follows:

- Section 1. No sign of any kind shall be displayed to public view on any lot, except for when a lot, or a house on a lot, is for sale, one (1) sign not more than three (3) feet by two (2) feet in size advertising such sale may be placed on the lot for sale only;
- Section 2. The height of any sign shall not exceed 3 ½ feet above the original ground level of the lot along the street frontage prior to construction;
- Section 3. The colors displayed on any sign shall be natural earth tones;
- Section 4. This Ordinance does not apply to any pre-existing signs on private properties, such as no trespassing, private drive or directional signs, which were present before the enactment of this Ordinance.
- Section 5. Other future signs must be approved by the City Council prior to installation; and
- Section 6. Any person, corporation, firm or other entity violating any section of this ordinance upon conviction thereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per violation. Each day during which such violations continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and upon publication.
