RESOLUTION NO. 1 2003


WHEREAS, the City Council of Glenview, Kentucky held a special meeting on September 10, 2003 to consider an emergency related to the deteriorating condition of two bridges on Longview Lane; and

WHEREAS, the City's engineer has reported that there is a high likelihood of a catastrophic failure of one or both bridges, that immediate repairs are needed to insure the safety of persons traversing the bridges, that a failure would prevent police, fire, EMS, and other emergency vehicles, from responding to the area, and this failure to respond could result in loss of life or property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. The City hereby accepts the lowest and most acceptable bids received by the City's engineer so that immediate repairs can be completed on the two bridges;
2. The City hereby authorizes the payment of \$6,700.00 for repairs to the bridge closest to River Road and the payment of \$50,000.00 for repairs to the second bridge located to the south of the first bridge.
3. The council voted 3-0 to adopt this Resolution on the 10th day of September, 2003.

ORDINANCE 1 , SERIES 2003

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LICENSE FEE UPON INSURANCE COMPANIES FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GLENVIEW BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2003, AND THEREAFTER ON A CALENDAR YEAR BASIS; ESTABLISHING INSURANCE COMPANY LICENSE FEE RATE AS 5% OF THE FIRST YEAR PREMIUMS FOR LIFE INSURANCE AND 5% OF THE PREMIUMS FOR ALL OTHER TYPES OF INSURANCE ACTUALLY COLLECTED DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2003 AND THEREAFTER UNTIL AMENDED; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JULY 1, 2003, AND A DELINQUENCY DATE THIRTY 30 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH CALENDAR QUARTER; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY INTEREST CHARGE AT THE TAX INTEREST RATE AS DEFINED BY STATUTE; AND REQUIRING INSURANCE COMPANIES SUBJECT TO THE LICENSER FEE TO FURNISH ANNUAL COLLECTION INFORMATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GLENVIEW:

- Section 1. That there is hereby imposed on each insurance company a license fee for the privilege of engaging in the business of insurance within the corporate limits of the City of Glenview beginning on July 1, 2003, and thereafter on a calendar year basis.
- Section 2. That license fee imposed upon each insurance company which issues life insurance policies on the lives of persons residing within the corporate limits of the City of Glenview shall be 5% of the first year's premiums actually collected within each calendar quarter by reason of the issuance of such policies.
- Section 3. The license fee imposed upon each insurance company which issues any insurance policy which is not a life insurance policy shall be 5% of the premiums actually collected within each calendar quarter by reason of the issuance of such policies on risks located within the corporate limits of the City of Glenview on those classes of business which such company is authorized to transact, less all premiums received for insuring employers against liability for personal injuries to their employees, or death caused thereby, under the provisions of the Workers Compensation Act and shall not include premiums received on policies of group health insurance provided for state employees under KRS 18A.225(2) and 18A.228.

- Section 4. All license fees imposed by this ordinance shall be due no later than thirty (3) days after the end of each calendar quarter. License fees which are not paid on or before the date shall bear interest at the tax interest rate as defined in KRS 131.010(6).
- Section 5. Every insurance company subject to the license fees imposed by this ordinance shall annually, by March 31, furnish the City of Glenview with a written breakdown of all collections in the proceeding calendar year for the following categories of insurance: (a) casualty; (b) automobile; (c) inland marine; (d) fire and allied perils; (e) health; and (f) life.
- Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this ordinance, and any amendment thereto, to the Commissioner of Insurance of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and upon publication.
